Activity	Teacher Profile
English	Our English teachers are either QTS-qualified educators or TEFL/TESOL-certified tutors who work in international schools across Malaysia. They have experience teaching a range of age groups from 7–16 and are skilled in delivering differentiated lessons focused on speaking, reading, writing, and listening. Many also support school literacy programmes and EAL learners.
Sports	Our sports coaches are professionally qualified (e.g. FA-trained football coaches, swimming instructors, and PE specialists) and have worked extensively within international school settings. They regularly lead school teams, manage after-school sports clubs, and deliver structured physical education sessions tailored to different age groups.
STEAM	STEAM sessions are led by international school teachers or external specialists who contribute to school CCA programmes and enrichment days. Their backgrounds include science teaching, robotics, coding, and engineering projects. Many have run STEM clubs, science fairs, and inquiry-based workshops in international school settings.

How our English Classes Work

Our English programme is built on internationally recognised standards, with lessons carefully aligned to Cambridge English CEFR levels (A1–B1). The focus is on helping students gain confidence, accuracy, and fluency in everyday English through structured, interactive, and age-appropriate activities.

Each day includes one full English session led entirely in English by qualified teachers (QTS or TEFL/TESOL certified) with experience in international schools. Students are grouped by age and assessed level, ensuring the lessons are both challenging and achievable for each learner.

Key Features of the English Programme:

- Grammar Emphasis
- Our lessons prioritise core grammar development using practical exercises. Students are explicitly taught grammar rules and apply them in speaking and writing tasks.
- Integrated Skills Approach
- All four key skills — speaking, listening, reading, and writing — are included daily, with balanced time spent on communication and comprehension.
- Regular Assessment and Feedback
- Students are assessed through informal activities, written tasks, and end-of-week presentations. Instructors provide personalised feedback to support individual growth.
- Real-Life Application
- Through storytelling, project work, and group presentations, students use English in real scenarios that promote confidence, critical thinking, and creativity.

The overall aim is to strengthen each child’s ability to use English in both academic and social settings, while fostering a positive attitude toward language learning.
